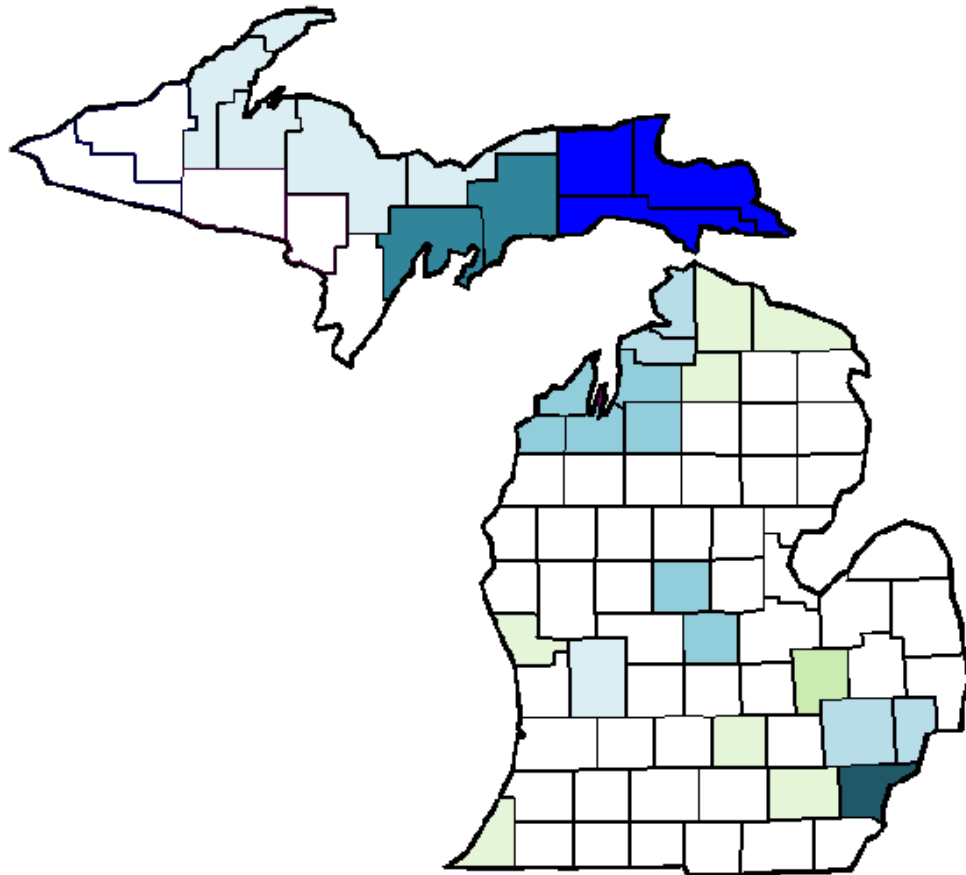

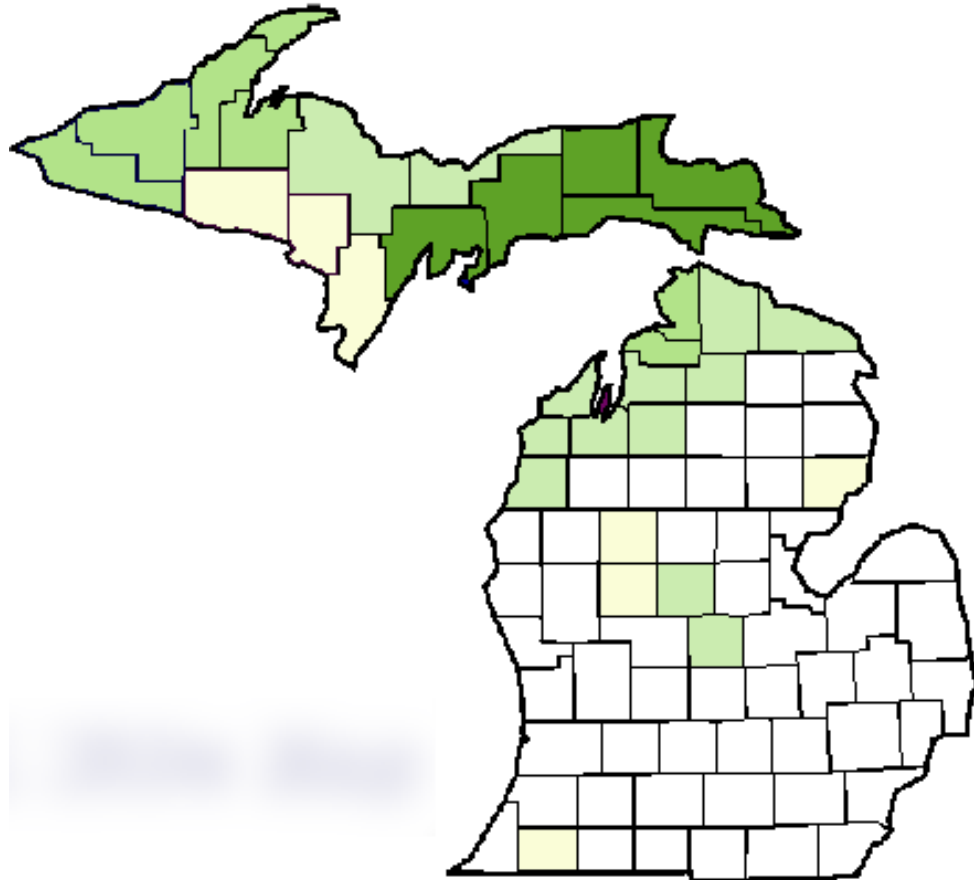

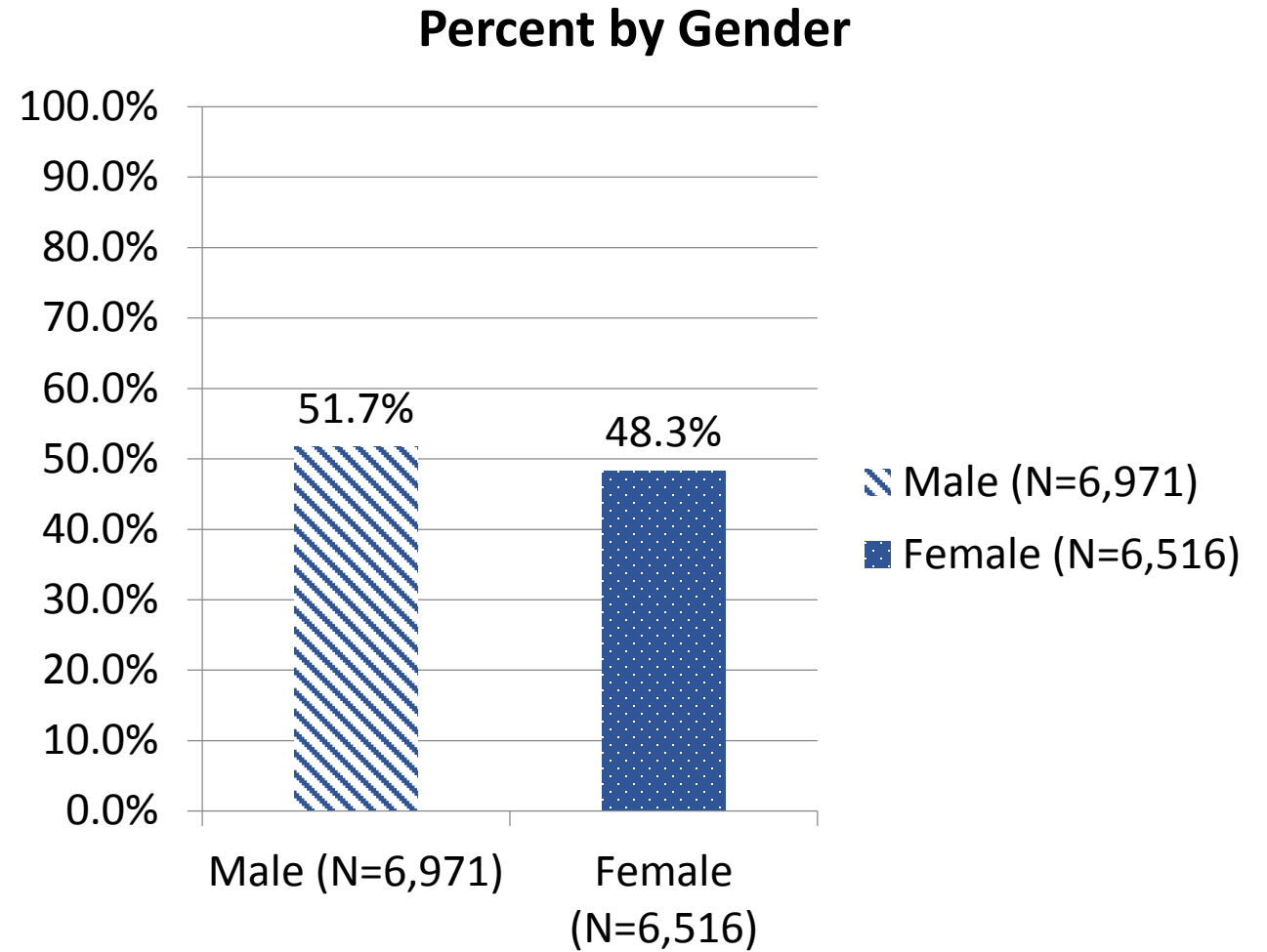

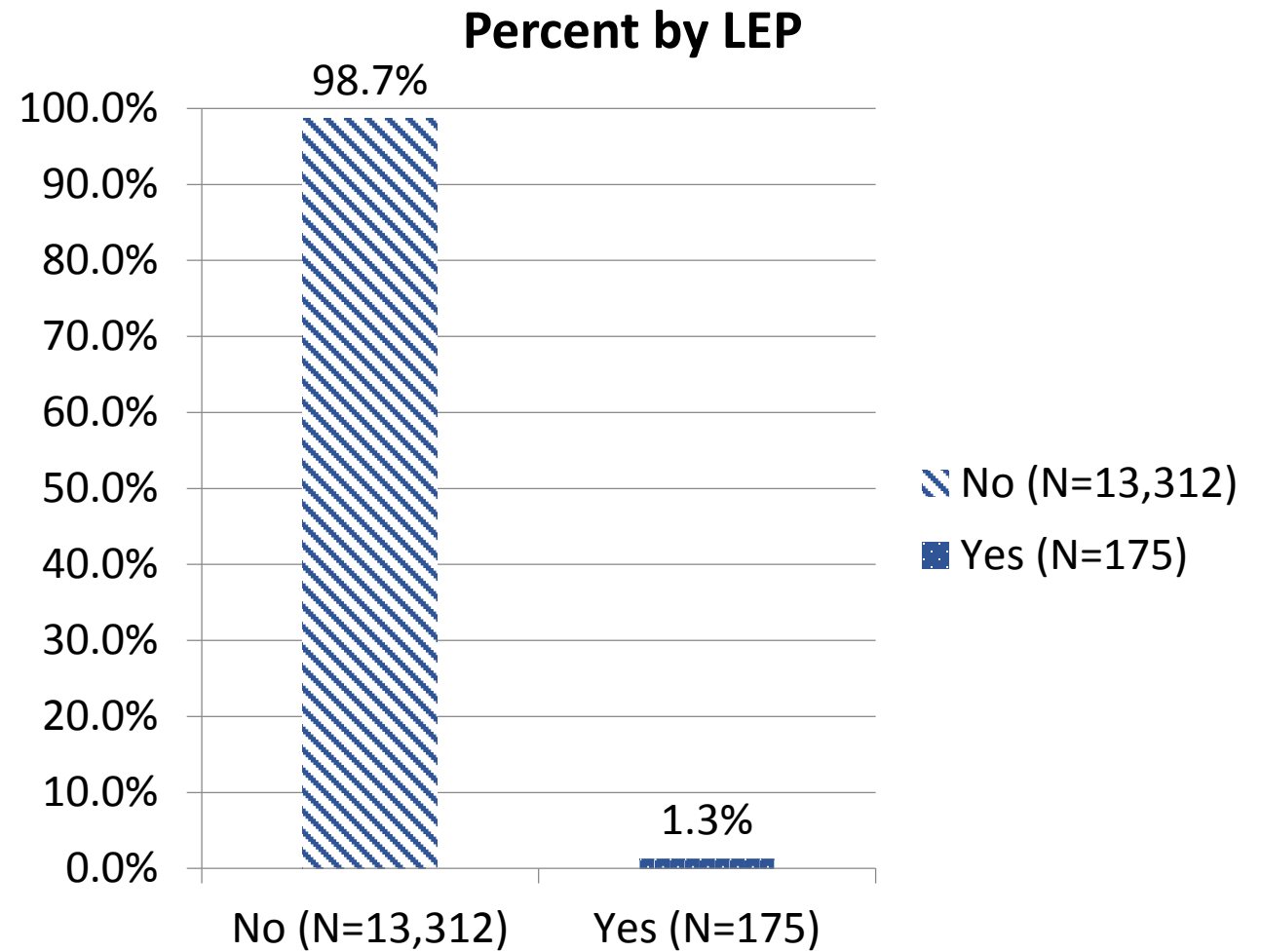

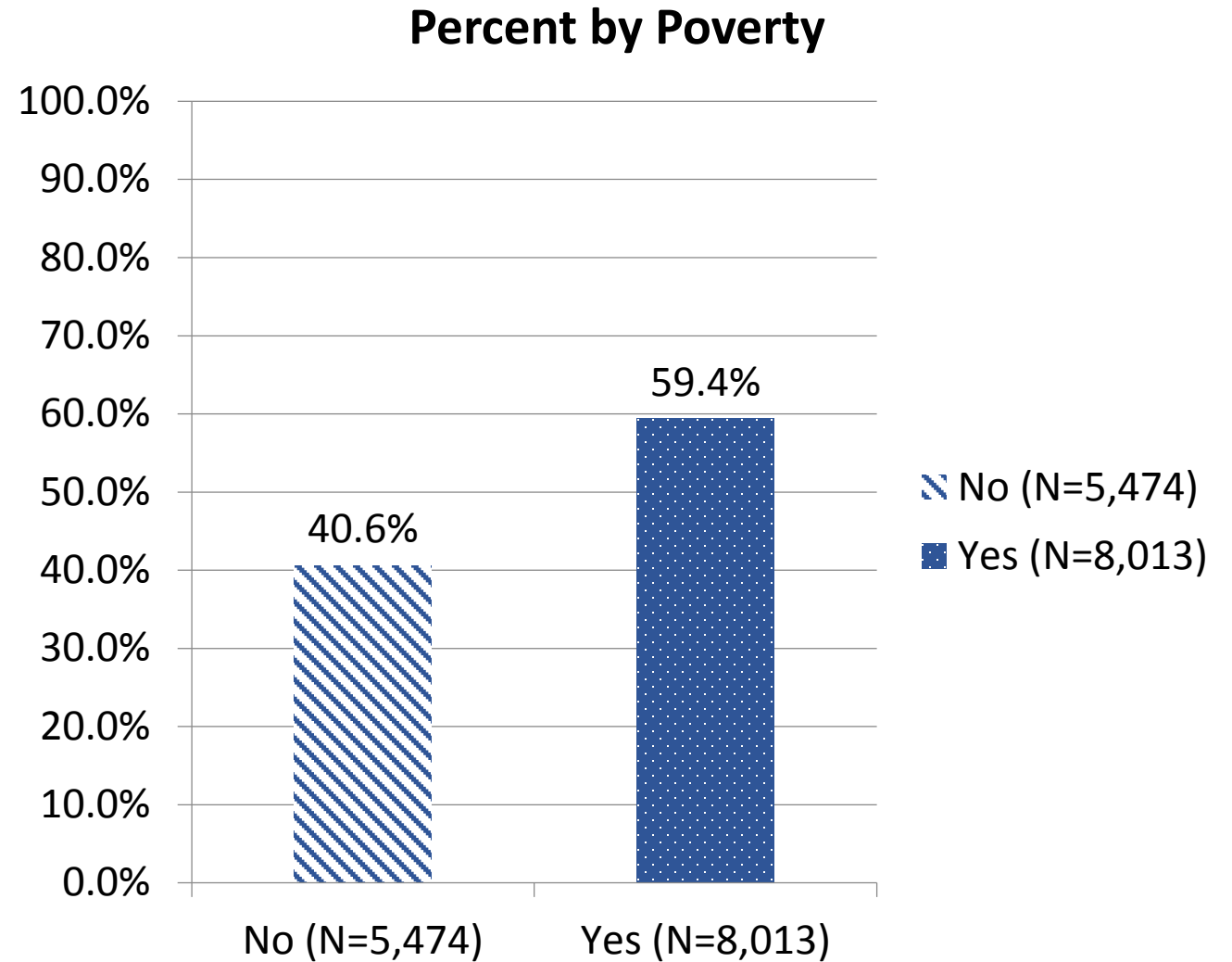
# Native Americans in Michigan By Limited English Proficient (LEP)

# Native Americans in Michigan By Poverty

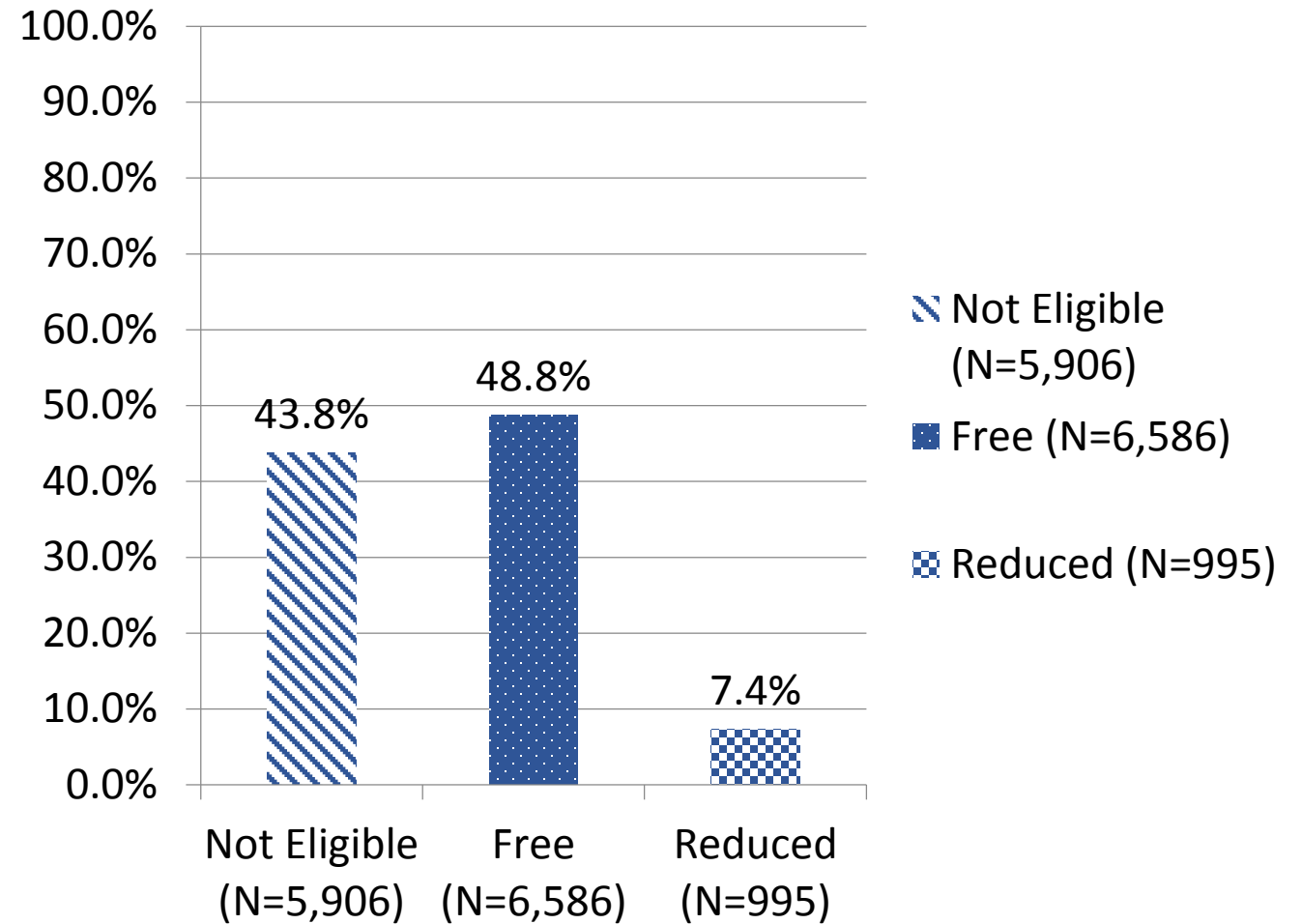
Economically disadvantaged students based on migrant, homeless, supplemental nutrition eligibility and direct certification status.



# Native Americans in Michigan By Free & Reduced

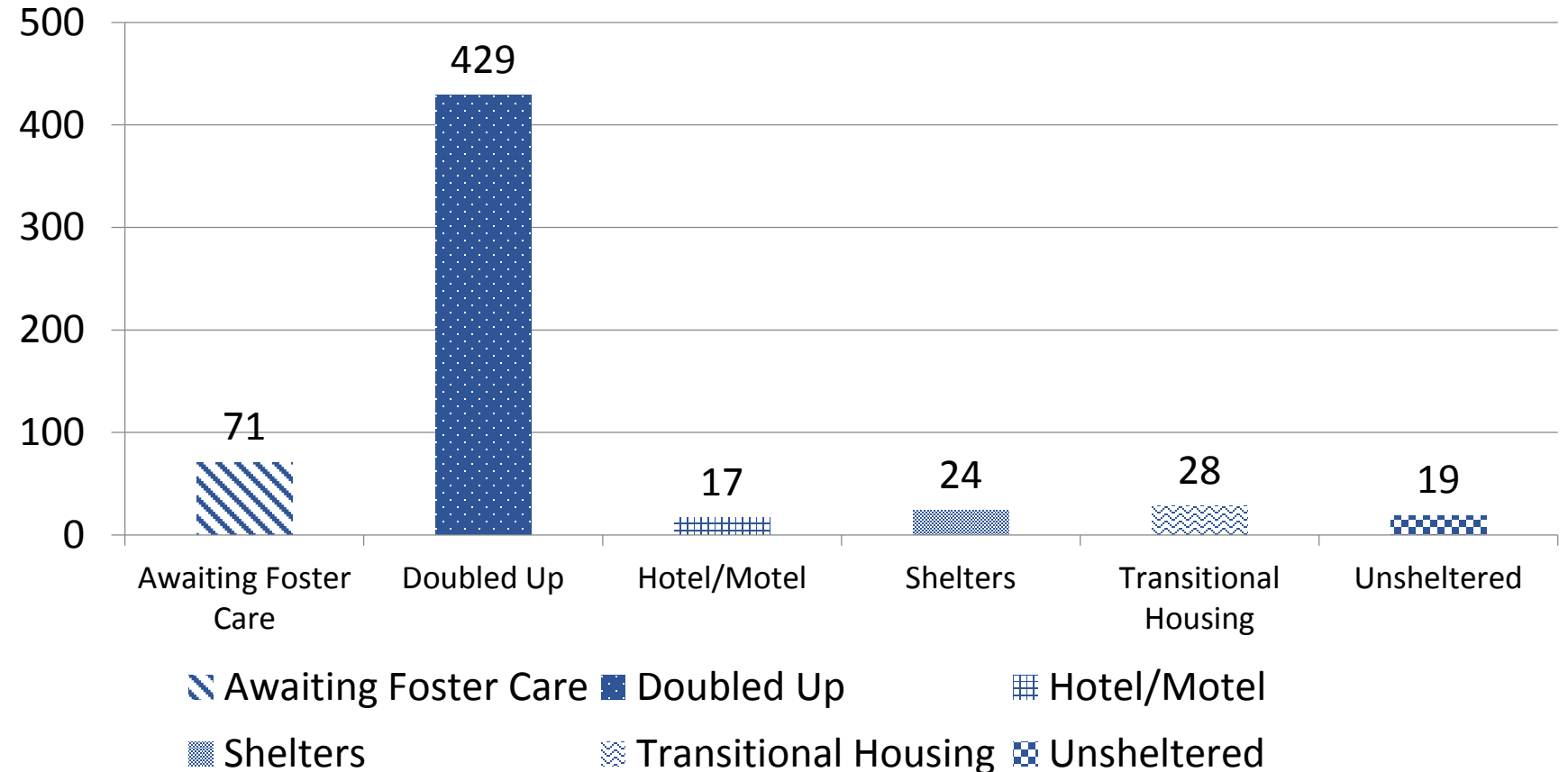
**Note:** Type of categorical program or services for which the student is eligible and in which he/she participates.

## Number by Homeless Code



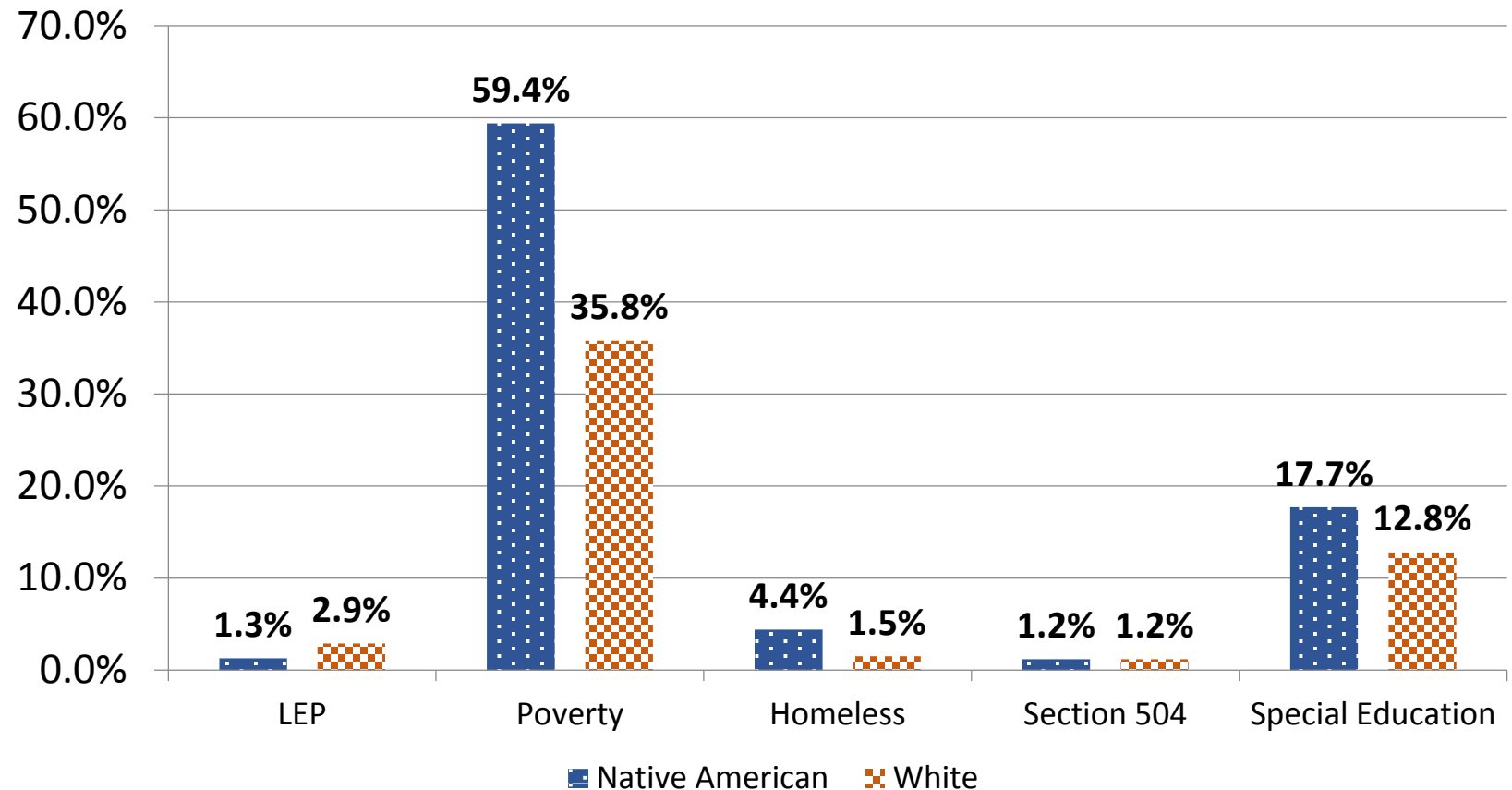

- Nearly 3 times more likely to be homeless.
- 40% more likely to have a disability.

Percent of Native Americans to White Students



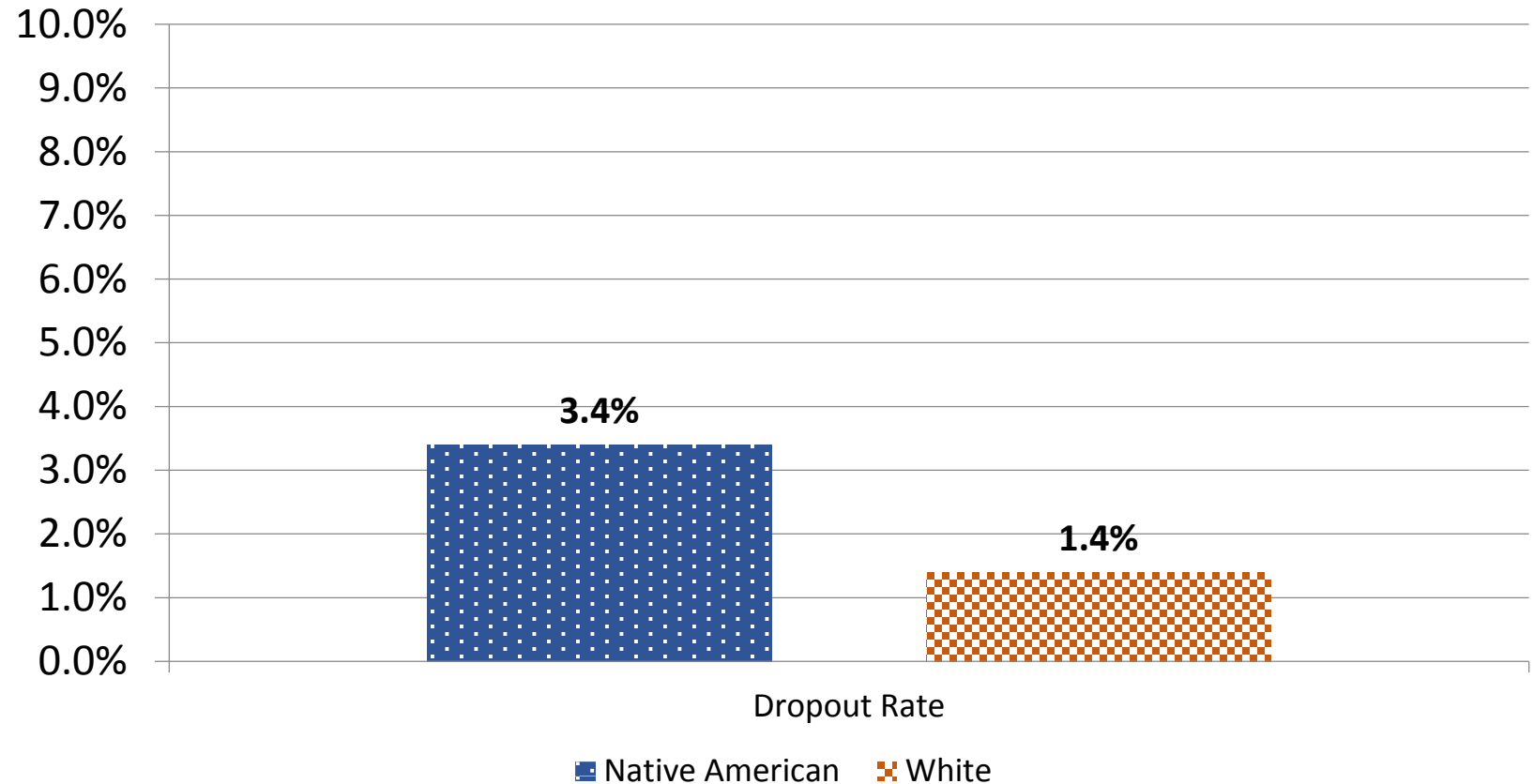

**Dropout Rate**

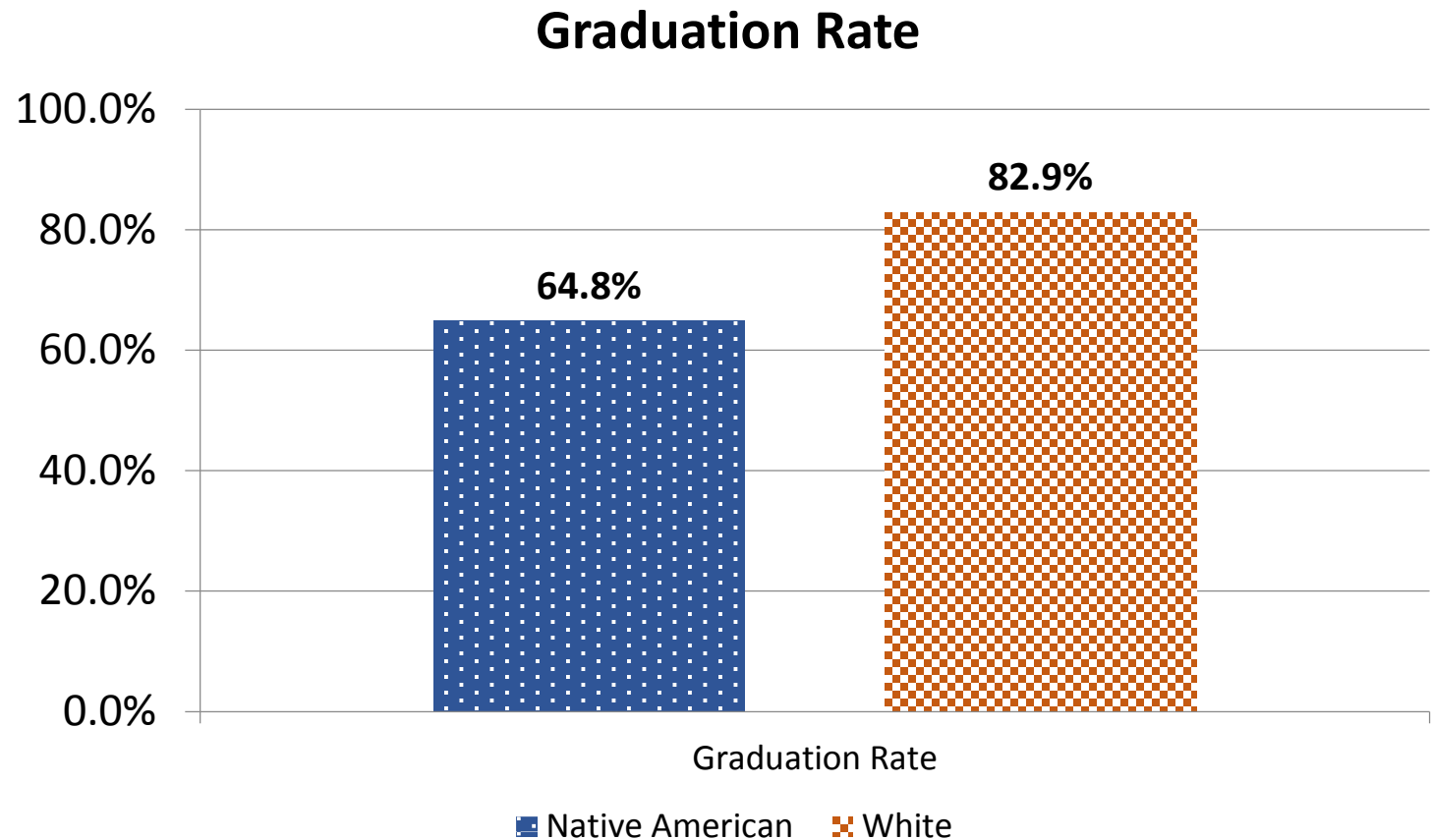
• More than twice as likely to dropout



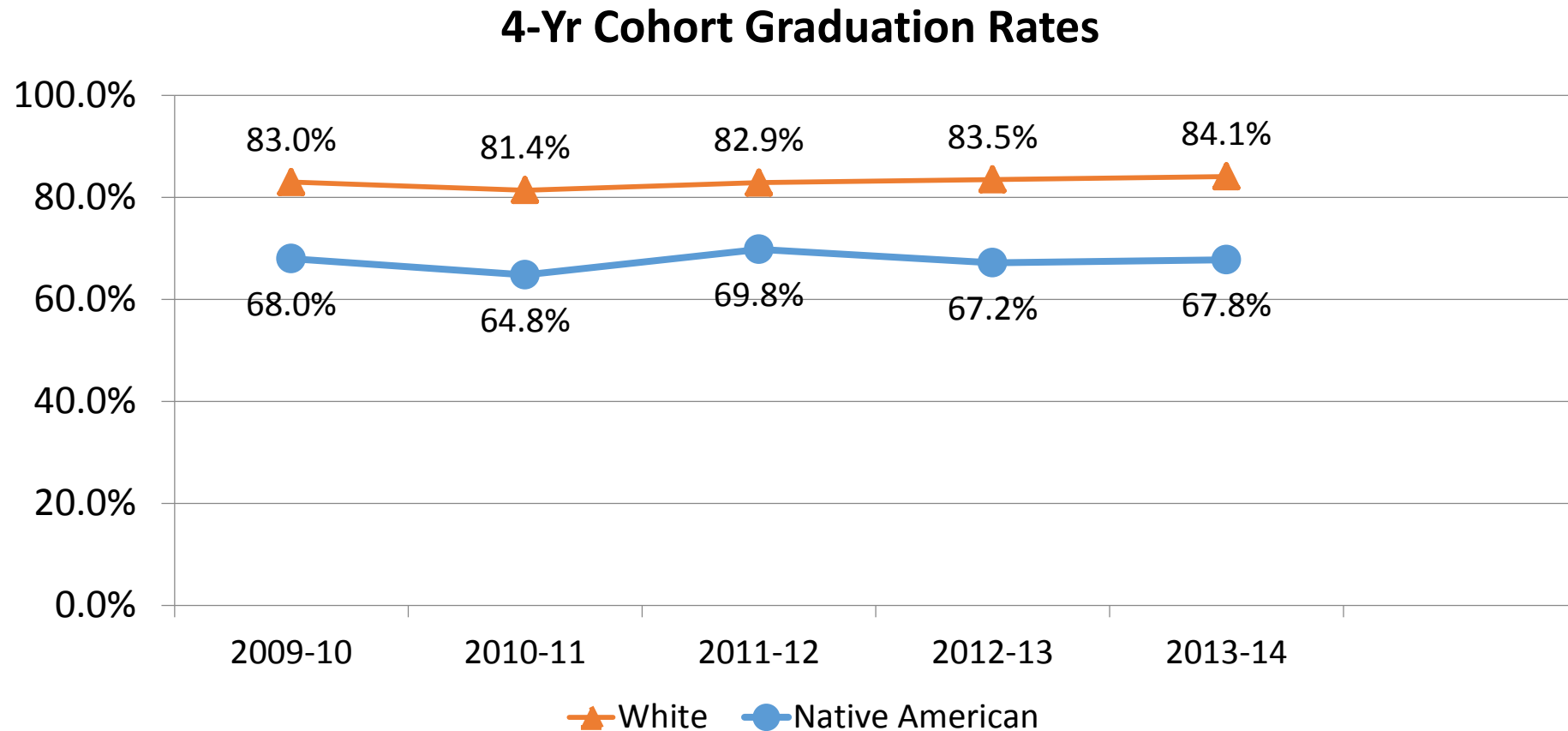
# Native American Graduation Rate Compared to White Students in Michigan

# Disparities in Graduation Rates Remain Stable Over Time



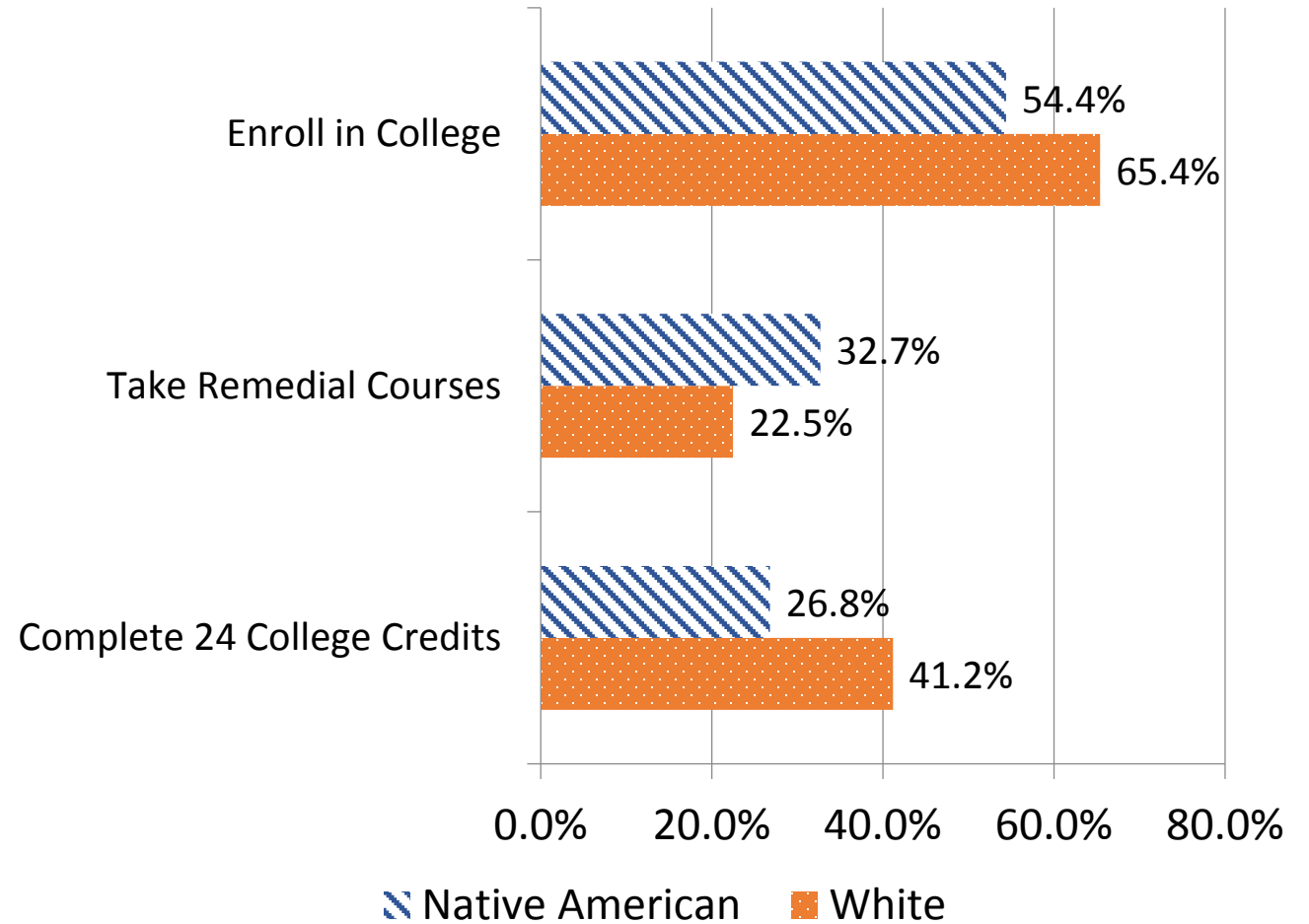
# Disparities Continue into Post-High School Education & Training

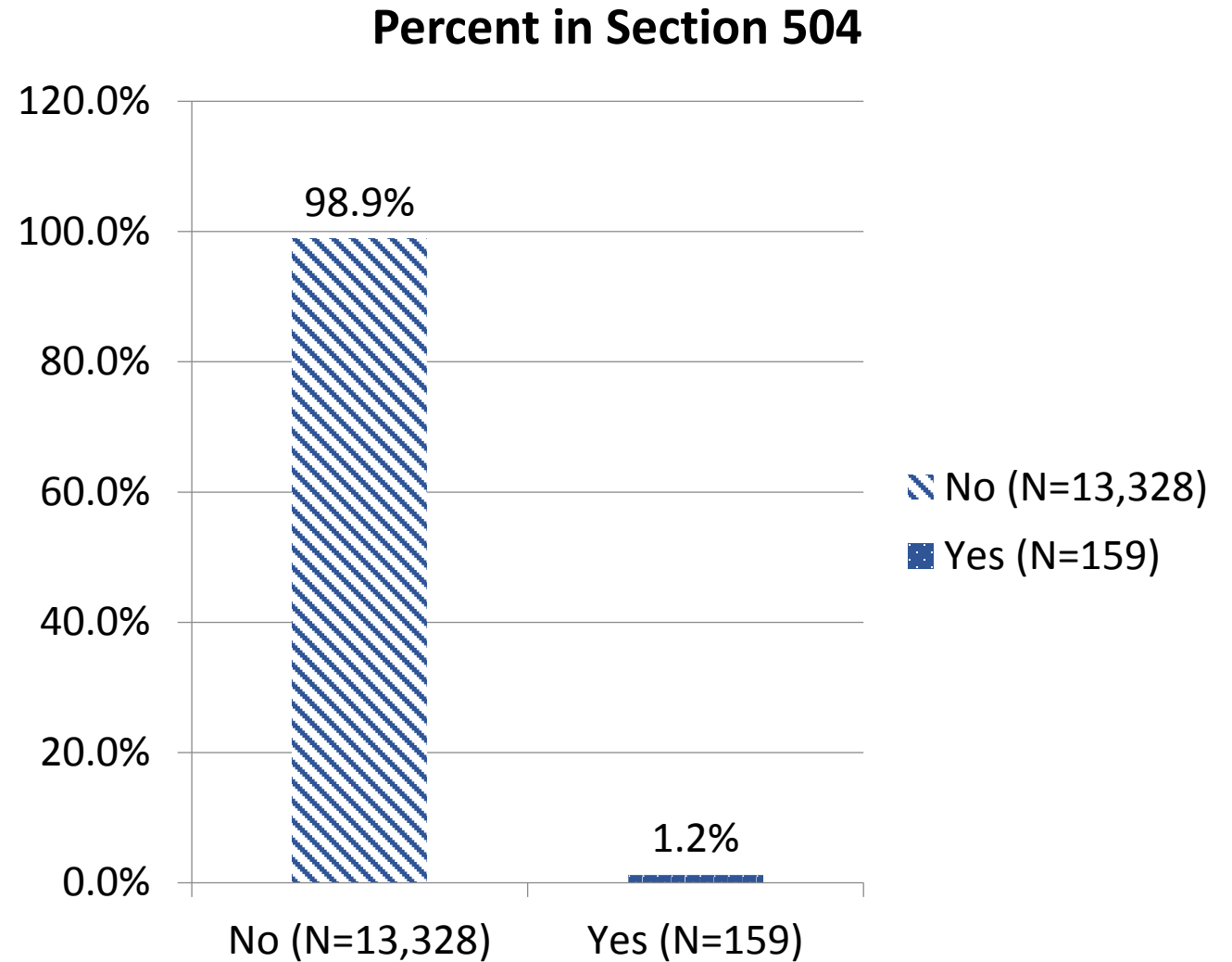
## Percent of High School Graduates Who ...

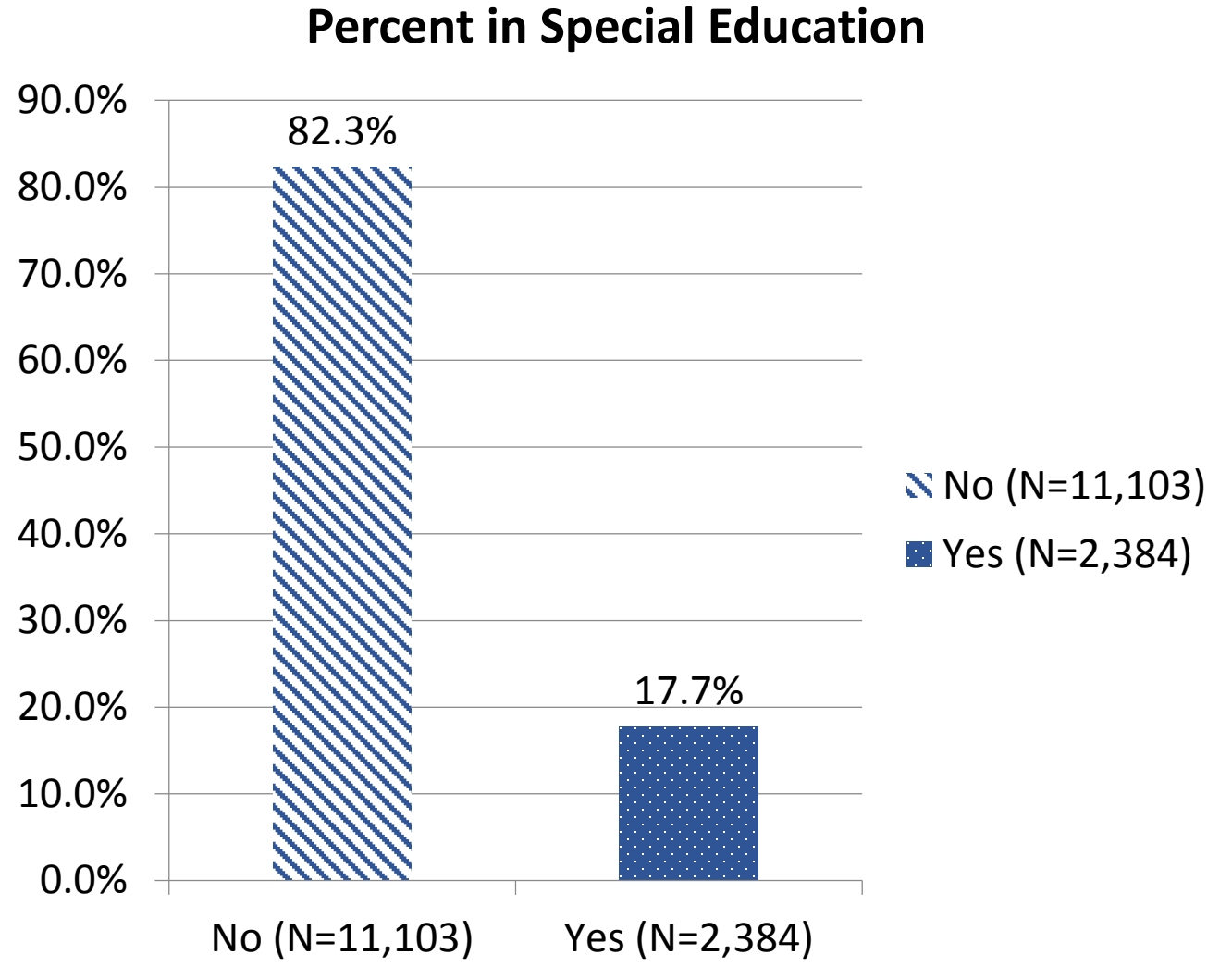
# Native Americans in Michigan In Section 504 Program
